Gaining a cosmopolitan and transnational perspective on place and history allows a rethinking of identities and boundaries that creates a multicultural and multi-narrative reading of current and past realities. This ability is important in today's world of increasing sectarian and nationalist polarization, producing important counter-narrative that is local, national as well as transnational in scope.

About Summer School

This summer school will take place in two weeks, comprised of five-day lectures and group field research. During the first week, lectures on the theories of the transnational approach and history and its relationship with non-state identity formation, including religion, ethnic, racial, class and others will be given by experts on the related field. The program then will be followed by group field research at communities and urban spaces of Yogyakarta, including Chinatown district of Ketandan, Muslim district of Kauman, communities of art, popular culture consumption and so forth. Students will meet with members of each communities and participate in their activities. Both the meetings and activities can hopefully create new linkages. For administration purposes, this summer school is equivalent to 3 credits and is transferable. There is also USD150 grant available for 10 students from Southeast Asian countries (except Indonesia) who write best motivation letter.
